1. The cabinet system is **DESIGNED FOR REQUIRED ESSENTIAL TOOLS ONLY**. It is not designed to accommodate ALL of your legacy tools. Additional cabinets can be sourced or purchased for these tools. There is no catalog for these legacy tools.
2. Subaru of America has recently removed many tools that are no longer required. In the catalog these are highlighted, greyed out in the master index. You only need required non-highlighted tools listed in the catalog as per the franchise agreement.
3. Should you have purchased cabinets up until December of 2014, drawer liners were provided with illustrations. The latest shipped tool cabinets from 2014 on **WILL NOT** be included on the drawer liners. The liners will not be updated. The latest shipped tools will be placed in non-illustrated pockets.
4. The new layout for the catalog allows us to improve the catalog illustrations for more accurate identification. This was not the case with the liners. We think you will like these new improved illustrations
5. It is expected that as time goes on, additional tools will be removed, at some point the previously supplied illustrated liners will be obsolete, need to be turned over and the white non-illustrated side is used. That is why we introduced the new style catalog.
6. The catalog is the latest and only accurate document for tool storage. If it gets damaged, lost, simply download a new one. Set printer to color.
7. The reference in the tool catalog now references a drawer only. Due to drawer and tool configurations, it is no longer possible to arrange cabinets by vehicle area. This allows for future tool expansion for new models
